

**Town of Lessor
Town Board Meeting
April 10, 2018**

Chairman Zernicke **calls the meeting** to order at 8:00 pm. Chairman; Delmar Zernicke, Supervisors; Ken Holmes and David Owen, Treasurer; Lisa Clauss and Clerk; Katie Sprangers are present. Guest attending are Lynn Hrabik, Rebecca Fields, Lois Selle, Jaime Owen, Matt Maroszek, Tony Letter and H. Michalski.

Ken motions to accept the agenda and deviate from the agenda if necessary, Dave seconds and the motion carries.

The minutes from the Town Board Meeting on March 13th are read by Katie. Dave motions to approve the minutes, Ken seconds and the motion carries. Ken motions to approve the treasurer's report, Dave seconds and the motion carries.

Open Floor: A resident reported that on March 18, 2018 shooting along with tanerite occurred for over 4 hours and she feels it was excessive. The sheriff's department was called and a visit was made. She was told without a noise ordinance there is nothing that can be done. Katie and Becky verified that the Town does not have a noise ordinance. Discussion occurred about dangers and distances from other homes. An inquiry on fixing Two Creek Road including culverts, Delmar says it will be fixed this year.

Communications: The county will inspect all bridges in the county. Katie will report what roadwork is being done to WE Energies. Jeff Nass has proposed painting the flag pole, ideas for repairing the light and providing flags as needed in an email to the Town Board which Katie read aloud. Ken states that Pete's Electric has fixed the light on the flag. The board instructs Katie to write Jeff a letter of thanks and they will take his offer into consideration. Flags are provided by our Senate/Assembly representatives for free to our town hall already. A invitation to a pipeline seminar in Steven's Point is shared. A complaint about how much gravel was plowed off the roads with the spring snow was made. A request for crack sealing to be bid from a new company was shared, the crack sealing for 2018 has already been contracted. Katie will keep the letter on file for 2019.

Roadwork: Some discussion about some culverts needing to be replaced/repared with Matt Maroszek. Tree removal from the right of way will be happening this spring. Discussion about gravel road options for spring occurred.

Fire Department: Checks numbered 3920-3929 were signed by Delmar.

Expenditures: Ken motions to approve the payroll, Dave seconds and the motion carries. Dave motions to approve the expenditures, Ken seconds and the motion carries. Checks numbered 5671-5702 are signed.

Annual meeting lunch is planned to be provided by the Town Officials. Gary is no longer able to clean or maintain the Town Hall. Katie will put the position on the agenda for the Town Board Meeting on April 17 at 7:45 pm

Ken motions to accept NEA's bid for grinding Old W and Mapleview and blacktopping Old W, Mapleview and Shady, Dave seconds and the motion carries. Shouldering is tabled for now.
