ORDINANCE #2-95 AMENDMENT TO #1-94 RECYCLING ORDINANCE FOR MANDATORY RECYCLING

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Lessor adopted regulations regarding collection, removal and disposal of solid waste in the Town and provided for mandatory recycling of recyclable items, with the passage of Ordinance #1-94, and;

WHEREAS, it was intended that this Ordinance comply with mandatory recycling legislation included in Chapter 159 of the Wis. Stats. and Chapter NR 544 of the Wisc. Adm. Code, and;

WHEREAS, the DNR has required that the Town of Lessor modify its recycling ordinance and program to meet the requirements of s. 159.01(3), Stats., and Chapter NR 544, Wis.Adm. Code.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Town Board of the Town of Lessor, do ordain as follows:

Section 1.10(6) is hereby amended to read as follows:

(6) "Major Appliance" means a commercial or residential furnace, boiler, dehumidifier, water heater, range, microwave oven (from which the capacitor has been removed), refrigerator, freezer, air conditioner, dishwasher, clothes washer, clothes dryer and television.

Section 1.14 is hereby amended to read as follows:

MANAGEMENT OF LEAD ACID BATTERIES, MAJOR APPLIANCES, WASTE
OIL, YARD WASTE AND WASTE TIRES.

Subparagraph 1.14(5) is hereby added:

(5) Waste tires shall be returned to the place of purchase, brought to the landfill by the individual or a contract waste hauler for recycling.

This Ordinance Amendmentshall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
