PETITION TO COUNTY BOARD  
WHITE LAKE WATERSHED AREA

WHEREAS, The White Lake Watershed is proposed for several significant housing development projects which may change the nature of White Lake and its surroundings, and

WHEREAS, White Lake is a shallow, spring-fed lake with no outlet, and as such is susceptible to nutrient inflow which could degrad water quality and fishery potential, and which could possibly result in excessive weed growth and/or algal blooms, and


WHEREAS, a land use planning effort which included education, citizen involvement, and exploration of management alternatives began during 1994 and has culminated in the preparation of a set of proposed special zoning district regulations for the purpose of protecting White Lake from adverse impacts, and

WHEREAS, a zoning moratorium is now in effect in the Town, but which must be lifted or extended as of February 13, 1997.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board of Supervisors hereby petitions the Shawano County Board of Supervisors to approve and adopt the attached "Proposed Amendments to the Shawano County Shoreland Zoning Ordinance, White Lake Protection District in the Towns of Lessor and Hartland", resulting in inclusion of the admendments within the Shawano County Shoreland Zoning Ordinance.




